

Starting in 2019, K9 handler Deputy Joseph Breeser of the Crawford County Sheriff's Department began receiving information from surrounding agencies that a female identified as Pa Yang from Onalaska, WI was involved in the illegal distribution of large quantities of methamphetamine in southwest Wisconsin. During 2020, Deputy Breeser conducted three cold (random) traffic stops in Crawford County where his partner, K9 Breck was deployed. K9 Breck alerted during all three stops and an approximate 2.5 ounces of methamphetamine was seized from Yang. In the time proceeding the stops, Deputy Breeser compiled countless social media search warrants and conducted numerous interviews of confidential sources.

Based on information obtained by Deputy Breeser and other Investigators, in February of 2021, Deputy Breeser assisted the West Central Metropolitan Enforcement group in La Crosse County, WI. A traffic stop was conducted on Yang in Onalaska, WI where K9 Breck again was deployed. Based on K9 Breck's alert, approximately four ounces of methamphetamine was seized from Yang. In April of 2021, a traffic stop was conducted in Crawford County based on Deputy Breeser's investigation, in which K9 Breck was later deployed on the vehicle. K9 Breck alerted to vehicle and over 3 pounds of methamphetamine was seized.

Deputy Breeser continued his investigation in which numerous local, state and federal agencies became involved and assisted. Eventually in February 2022, a traffic stop was conducted on Yang, which later led to Deputy Breeser arresting Yang's supplier in Prairie du Chien, WI. During this stop, Deputy Breeser seized approximately a quarter pound of methamphetamine.

Based on the work of K9 Breck and his handler Deputy Breeser, nearly four pounds of methamphetamine have been seized, resulting in the federal indictments of three individuals.
