The Waukesha Police Department is hosting an entry-level canine decoy training seminar on June 21st through June 23rd, 2022. The course will be instructed by Jessie Smith of Jessiffany Canine Services (Iron Ridge, WI). The class will run from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM daily, and will be conducted at Blair School, 301 Hyde Park Ave Waukesha, WI.

The cost of the class will be \$150 per decoy. Your agency's canine/handler teams are welcomed to attend free of charge with your decoys. Participants are encouraged to bring your agency's bite suit and other protective equipment. The class will be limited to around ten participants to ensure an adequate amount of repetitions, however this may be adjusted depending on interest. The enrollment deadline will be Tuesday 06/07/2022, at 1500 hours.
